



The FRIAS School of Life Sciences – LifeNet invites applications for

3 Internal Senior Memberships

(FRIAS short-term Fellowships)

in the wider field of biological complex systems, where the School brings together scientists from experimental and theoretical biology, medicine and physics.

The **one-month** memberships are offered to faculty members of the University of Freiburg who wish to benefit from the interdisciplinary and international surrounding of FRIAS to advance a research project of their own choice. Members are given the opportunity to retract to FRIAS, take advantage of the infrastructure of the institute, and pursue a project – if appropriate also in collaboration with another researcher, a FRIAS fellow or a renowned international scientist to be invited to FRIAS. Alternatively, several scientists can be invited for shorter periods. The travel and accommodation costs of the international guests will be covered by the School.

The memberships are granted for the period of one month and the successful applicants are free in choosing the timing of their membership – provided their absence during teaching periods is supported by their faculties.

Interactions with researchers from other departments of the University of Freiburg are encouraged. A documented interest in conducting research with an interdisciplinary focus is particularly fostered.

Applications should include a motivation letter, CV, list of publications, and a concrete project proposal (about 1 page, clearly stating the aim of the membership and a concise justification for all guest scientists to be invited).
